Coin Bank Bottles

Having clean water for drinking, cooking, and cleaning is always important so families can take care of each other. It is even more important now, with the COVID-19 pandemic! Week of Compassion is helping families have access to things like water and soap to stay healthy. You can use these labels to transform an empty bottle into a coin bank (you may need to get an adult to help you). Even small coins can make a big difference, when we all give what we can!

- 1. Find a bottle.
- 2. Print the label that is the right size for your bottle.
- 3. Cut along the dotted line.
- 4. Wrap the label around the bottle, then secure it with tape or glue.
- 5. Collect coins or bills to help people around the world.
- 6. Donate the amount you have collected to Week of Compassion. Have an adult help you donate by mail, online at weekofcompassion.org/donate or by texting **WoC** to **71777**.
- 7. Reuse or recycle your bottle.
